A chapter in an authored ebook from an academic collection should be treated as a chapter in an authored print book with the reference ending with the publisher. For a chapter in an authored print book or ebook with a DOI, see Chapter in an Authored Book with a DOI.

### **APA Citation Style: How to format a chapter citation**

The 7th edition of APA does not differentiate between the format of the books, print or electronic. Cite both the same way. If you have an open-access eBook, you may provide the URL at the end, provided it directly takes you to the full text without logging in.

### **Book Examples - APA (7th edition) Citation Guide ...**

When referring to a chapter in an authored book, usually you would not cite that chapter in the reference list. Instead, you would cite the whole book and, if necessary, cite the chapter in text. This rule applies whether the chapter is written by one of the book's primary authors or by a separate contributor.

APA citation basics When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, like, for example, (Jones, 1998). One complete reference for each source should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

To cite a textbook in APA in text, include the author's last name in parentheses at the end of the sentence you're sourcing, followed by the publication date. For example, you would write, "(Johnson, 2018)." If there are multiple authors, list all of their last names in parentheses.
