Scientists kept having difficulties organizing the information about the 64 elements. They kept trying to organize them, but found no pattern between them. Many chemicals have very similar colours, lustre, and conductivity of electricity and heat. Scientists were able to classify only two groups of elements at this point: metals and non-metals.

IONIC VS. COVALENT COMPOUNDS LAB. A compound is defined as a chemical combination of two or more elements. A chemical bond is the "glue" holding together atoms of different elements. Ionic bonds generally occur between a metallic element and a nonmetallic element. Covalent bonds generally occur between two or more nonmetallic elements.
